(855) Modified Morgan \$13: pH, buffer pH (lime requirement), organic matter, Modified Morgan phosphorus, potassium, calcium, magnesium, aluminum, iron, zinc, and manganese.

Instructions: Place about 1 cup of your well-mixed soil sample into the sample container, close the container and label. For deep rooted tree fruits, a surface (SR) soil sample from the 0 - 8 inch depth and a sub-surface (SB) soil sample from the 8 - 24 inch depth is needed since these crops obtain many of their nutrients from the subsoil. Samples should be sent in separate mailing boxes. Indicate paired surface and subsurface samples on the front of this sheet by circling the paired samples.
